

**Quick Draw - The Next Generation
for artists 18 years-of-age and younger
Sunday, July 21, 2013**

1. **REGISTER:** Quick Draw registration will take place underneath the registration tent located on Harrison Street in downtown Easton beginning at 10 a.m. The Quick Draw registration fee is \$10 (or \$5 if you have already registered for workshops).
2. **BOUNDARIES:** Downtown Easton - Talbot Town to the north, the Academy Art Museum to the south, Washington Street to the west, and Hanson Street to the east.
3. **ARTISTS CREATE:** Before the event begins, the Quick Draw artists may choose a location within the boundaries. At 10:30 am, the artists begin to create *en plein air*! The artists must start with nothing pre-painted, pre-drawn or pre-sculpted, and create the Quick Draw artwork only during the Quick Draw time frame between **10:30am to 1:30pm**. Artwork created as a part of the Next Generation Workshops may be used as a Quick Draw completion painting as long as it is framed and available for sale. Any violators will be banned from future events.
4. **ARTISTS RETURN:** At 1:30 pm, the Quick Draw artists finish, and bring their just completed artworks and easels to S. Harrison Street, where the exhibit and judging take place on Harrison Street in front of the Bartlett Pear Inn. **Prior to the exhibition, each painting must be framed or matted, for ease of handling.**
5. **EXHIBIT & SALE:** All artists must be available for the exhibit, sale and judging from **1:30pm – 2:30pm**. Each artist must set up her/his easel on S. Harrison Street, and display his/her Quick Draw work on it. Event staff will be on site to assist artists. Each artwork must be for sale, and have a title and price. A sales ticket will be distributed during registration and must be completed and attached to the easel. Artists must stay next to their work during the exhibit and sale.
6. **COMMISSION:** There will be a 10% commission collected from the proceeds of each Quick Draw sale, which is used to fund this event. 6% Maryland State Sales Tax will be added to the price of each artwork that sells, which will be collected by the event staff. There will be event staff on hand to accept credit cards. The artist must provide her/his Social Security Number or Federal EIN for any sale over \$600.00
7. **JUDGING:** Beginning at 1:30 pm, the Quick Draw paintings are judged by 2013 Plein Air-Easton! Competition Judge, Don Demers.
8. **AWARDS:**

 - **Ages 0-11**
 - 1st –various product awards

9. **EXHIBIT CONCLUDES:** All paintings and easels must be picked up by 3pm. Plein Air-Easton! is not responsible for any equipment or artworks left after that time.
