

Spring Thing Plein Air Quick Draw Guidelines

Saturday May 12th, 2018

Celebrate Spring through Art! Join us for our Plein Air Quick Draw, a timed open-air painting contest. Artists set up within a designated area with a stamped blank canvas and their supplies. Participants will start painting at the sound of the horn and must be complete when the second horn sounds. All designated areas will have time monitors. Artists will then turn in their piece to the check-in area where pieces will be judged, awarded, and sold.

ARTISTS REGISTRATION:

Artists of all skill levels are welcome to join in this celebration of art. There are three registration divisions: Professional, Intermediate/Novice, and Youth/Family. Pre-registration is encouraged but day of registration will be available. Artists may use any medium but must paint in the plein air tradition (painting live scenes). The Professional and Intermediate/Novice divisions will be judged separately and are required to be displayed for sale at the end of the event. Our judge will be plein air painter, Joe Terrone. Youth/Family artwork may also be displayed and for sale, if so desired, but will not be judged.

Professional Artists: Registration is \$10.

- 1. Adults only (18 years or older).
- 2. Artists in this category must bring their own painting supplies, canvas, frame, and easels.
- 3. Canvases must be stamped at the time of registration.
- 4. This is a judged event.
- 5. Painting must be framed prior to turning into the check-in area.
- 6. Completed display form must be turned in with artwork title and sale price.

Intermediate/Novice Artists: Registration is free.

- 1. Artists must be 16 years or older.
- 2. A limited supply of paint kits will be available for \$15 and will include a stamped canvas and all painting supplies, but artists may bring their own canvas and supplies if desired.
- 3. A limited supply of easels will be available to borrow.
- 4. Canvases must be stamped at the time of registration.
- 5. This is a judged event, but artists may elect not to have their piece judged if so desired.
- 6. A completed display form must be turned in with artwork title and sale price.

Youth/Family: Registration is free.

- 1. For artists 15 years and younger or family groups.
- 2. An adult/guardian must accompany all children 12 and under.
- 3. A limited supply of paint kits will be available for \$8 and will include a stamped canvas and painting supplies, but artists may bring their own canvas and supplies if desired.
- 4. A limited supply of easels will be available to borrow.
- 5. Youth and Family artists must paint in their designated painting area as indicated on the map.
- 6. This is not a judged event, but artwork will be displayed and can be for sale if so desired.

SCHEDULE:

12:00 pm- 1:30 PM – Artists check in at the registration area, get canvas stamped and register, if not pre-registered.

A map will be provided indicating the perimeters of the designated painting areas. Artists are encouraged to arrive early to scout potential sites within the designated areas.

1:30- 2:00 PM – Set up at selected location. Be listening for the sounding of the horn signaling the 2:00 PM start time.

2:00 PM — Horn will sound and artists may begin painting en plein air style on any subject. No pre-painted or pre-drawn materials are allowed. The Quick Draw artwork must be created during the Quick Draw time frame (2-4 PM).

4:00 PM - The second horn will sound. All painting must stop at that time.

4:00 - 4:15 AM — Quick Draw artists must turn in their artwork at the check-in area. Artists should have display form completed and attached. Professional artists only: completed pieces must be framed as well.

4:15 – 4:45 PM – Quick Draw artwork is displayed, judged, and sale orders taken.

4:45 – 5:00 PM - Awards distributed and sales finalized. Unsold artwork must be picked up by 5:00 PM. Unclaimed artwork will be held at The Foundry for one week only.

JUDGING/AWARDS:

Quick Draw artwork must be turned in by 4:15 PM in order to be judged.

Professional Intermediate/Novice

1st Place Adult – \$100 1^{st} Place: Ribbon & \$25 gift card 2nd Place Adult – \$75 2^{nd} Place: Ribbon & \$15 gift card 3rd Place Adult – \$50 3^{rd} Place: Ribbon & \$10 gift card

Honorable Mention ribbons will be awarded at Judge's discretion.

All displayed Youth/Family artwork will receive a participation ribbon.

JUDGE'S BIOGRAPHY: JOSEPH TERRONE

Joseph Terrone is a professional Delaware-based Artist. He graduated from Pratt Institute with an MFA in painting and has earned New Jersey State Certification as an Instructor of Art. Mr. Terrone's plein air paintings have been collected throughout the country. Originating from his abstract art background coupled with his response to plein air painting, his paintings act as vehicles to express his love of nature through color and movement.
